WHO WE ARE

The St Jeanne Antide Foundation is a registered social purpose non-profit organisation. Its overarching objective is to provide a range of professional support services to very vulnerable individuals and families who face complex life challenges and to those who are sliding into poverty and are socially excluded. Professionals and volunteers work hand-in-hand in service delivery.

FOUNDED

Established by a legal deed as a Foundation in November 2007 and as a VO in May 2008.

SERVICES

1. Family Services Centre:

Ċentru Antida in the heart of Tarxien serving families from Tarxien, Paola, Fgura and Żabbar. Open daily from Mondays to Friday. Services include the following:

Social Work: home-visits, family care plans, advocacy, referral to other agencies, information dissemination, emotional support; non-formal education; support groups.

Learning Support for children of families supported by the Foundation.

74 Volunteers opportunities including: supported volunteering for service users, befrienders, mentors, reception workers and volunteer handymen in support of poor families.

In-kind support to poor families: food, personal hygiene items, clothing, furnishings, books, baby items and toys.

2. SOAR Service: Advocacy and support by survivors for victims and survivors of domestic violence (soarmalta@gmail.com); workshops for practitioners, information, start-up of a social enterprise called Meraki. **Facebook & Instagram:** Fondazzjoni St Jeanne Antide. **Email:** info@antidemalta.org

3. LWIEN Service: Support to family caregivers of persons with severe mental illness: family consultations by Senior Mental Health Nurse, support groups, home-visits, social work, literature.

4. Y-ASSIST service: Two residences for vulnerable homeless mothers and their children. The service includes accommodation, an educational programme, support mentors, volunteering and training that enables the mothers to move to independent living.

5. Emotional Freedom Service for persons wanting to be free from their anger, fear, grudges and resentment or other emotional distress. Workshops, live-ins, a Wholeness Group that meets monthly.

6. Social Work Service which cuts across all other SJAF core services.

BENEFICIARIES

From 2008 to December 2019: 5,935 individuals from 3,765 vulnerable families supported.
